Miss Wright + I are going to Hartford for lunch, just as we did a week ago. More for the sake of doing it than for any [shopping?] reason. [Altho'?] I do expect to get needed spats there + 2 more pain [stockins?].

I'm not sure whether this will find you in K. or at ship's, so will try where you last wrote. If it makes things rushed for you please don't come until [Twenty?]. Altho' if you can get off tomorrow (!!) it will be perfect.

Dr. H. is away now, for 2 or 3 days I think, + then C. was + Sunday [intervening?] he said it w'd be more time saving for Esther not to come until Monday. She would get all possible attention immediately then. Wh. is better for short stay, wouldn't make any dif. if it were

to be long. So I told him she would come here. I could meet her at Berlin in Hartford, or you + I together if you stay, if R. will put her on train in N. York this would make it perhaps easier for [them?]. + [then?] he would see [Crozer?] when she leaves. Any way tell E. I'd like to meet her if she wishes, + give her much love. And lots to dear S. + E.
