Miss Paul + Miss Younger + I dined at 5 at such a nice little restaurant + then I had an hour's rest (more) + here I am now at the N.A.W.S.A. meeting. Mrs. Catt is to speak on their [party?] we understand - so 8 of us are here in the front row of the top gallery, listening for the moment to secretly leave - they have all applauded some reference to the President, twice now. This meeting is so different from ours, it is really funny. Dr. Shaw is presiding. She wrote to me last night while she was sitting on the platform at their chapel meeting + said she would be looking for me this evening. She will see a bored countenance I fear.

There is danger of our bill being forced to a vote next week

and it means we all have to work hard to prevent such a disaster. We can get it through next month + we must shove it off. Fortunately the N.A.W.S.A thinks as we do, so they also will help stave it off.
