politics of any situation than the men who are old at the game do themselves. We expect to pull through all right. The outlook is better this morn. because we have brought the leaders of 2 opposing factions together & obtained from one (the Governor) a necessary concession. It's all frightfully secret, & only A.P. & I & the other 2 (gov. & the other man) know any thing about it. Our teleph. conversations are listened to, wires tapped & all that- It's quite amusing.

I've seen the pres. of the "other" suffragists 3 times this a.m., & we are co. operating beautifully- Hearing to-morrow, & I'm waiting now for a Washington call to ask Miss Pollitzer to try & secure 2 U.S. Senators for us- McKellar of Tennessee (Dem.) who was so fine in Maryland- & Senator Spencer of Missouri (Rep.) who is a good speaker from a party standpoint- The whole thing has to be worked through party pressure-
